Anthony M. Greenlee was born March 9, 1971. He gave his life to the Lord at 9 years old at New Jerusalem Institutional Baptist Church in Dallas, Texas. Anthony's heart was as strong as a bull, and it allowed him to pursue a football career. He excelled at football and in academics, graduating from W. W. Samuel High School in 1989. At the age of 17, Anthony was blessed to receive a 5-year scholarship for football to Oklahoma State University, and by God's grace a Bachelor of Science degree in Pre-Social Work/Sociology in the summer of 1995.

In the spring of 1992, Anthony was home on Spring Break from college. He confided in his mother, and told her that God was calling him to preach. She said, "Go back and ask Him again." He was sure then, but he battled with idea, and as most of us do, hid from his truth. Finally, he accepted his calling and started serving. Anthony attended The Potter's House School of Ministry from 2008-2010. He graduated in June 2010, and was ordained to preach and start his own ministry. He serves at The Potter's House of Dallas in The Ministerial Alliance of Ministers and Elders, and in The Bishop's Choir.

Anthony was doing all that God asked of him and life was good. Until, Anthony was diagnosed with congestive heart failure in 2002. Anthony wrestled with this diagnosis because he had been an athlete most of his life. He was strong, and was doing God's work. Why him, he thought? As his heart condition worsened throughout the years, Anthony was fighting to eat healthier, and make the necessary changes, but no progress. In 2015, Anthony's health spiraled out of control, and led him to be placed on the heart transplant list. Anthony surrendered his cry to God, and his family and friends gathered and prayed for a miracle on January 3, 2016 while in ICU. By grace, Anthony was called later that night reporting that he had a matching donor, and he received his new heart on January 4, 2016. Since then, Anthony has been faithful in his ministry and has launched **DEPUR Love Ministry, MMOV Conference (Might Man of Valor ~ The God Experience)** which will launch on June 7-8, 2018. This conference is going to be a mighty work of God that will empower, inspire, and rebuild those in the community that suffers with low self-esteem/perception, and live with fear which is stopping them from living their greatest life.
